APPLICATION DEADLINE: Monday, October 9, 2023

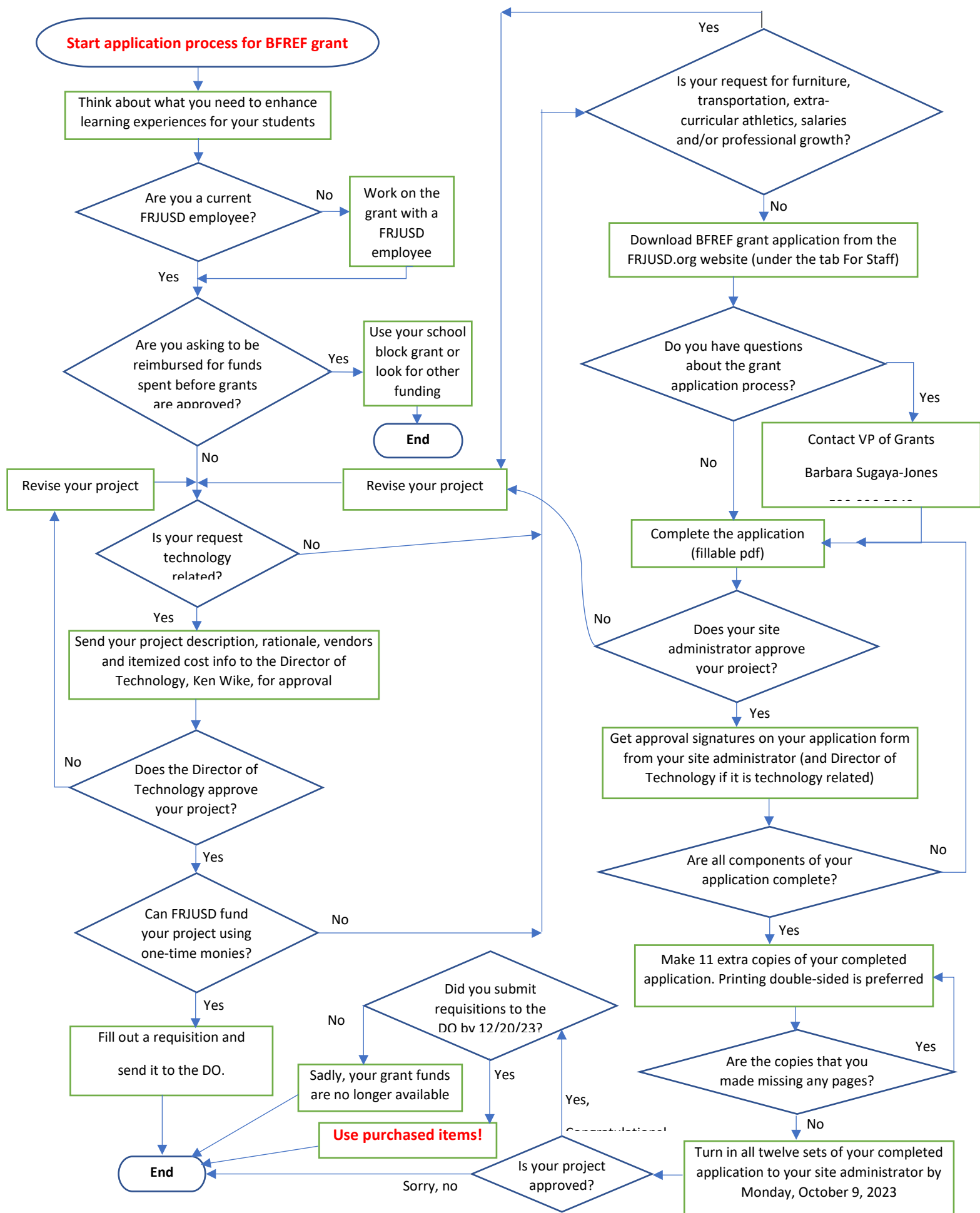
Twelve printed copies of your completed application, including all necessary signatures, need to be turned in to your site administrator by Monday, October 9, 2023.

Requirements:

1. Applicants must be current FRJUSD employees. The grant application can be found on the FRJUSD.org website under the tab For Staff. Complete all sections of the application.
Because the application is a fillable pdf, you can download it and type your answers directly into the highlighted boxes. You can also tell us to "See attached extra pages."
2. BFREF does **not** fund
 - furniture, transportation, extra-curricular athletics, salaries, or professional growth,
 - reimbursements for funds spent before grants are approved, or
 - incomplete grant applications.
3. Ken Wike, Director of Technology, must approve grants that involve technology. It is possible that one-time monies from FRJUSD can fund your technology grant without you needing to apply to BFREF. For BFREF grants, Ken Wike must receive your grant application by September 25, 2023 to review and process your technology needs. We encourage you to work with him early in your process to check compatibility, find vendors, and determine if the District can fund your purchase directly.
4. Obtain your administrator's signature of approval on the original grant application.
5. Submit 12 printed copies of the completed application to your site administrator by Monday, October 9, 2023. Do not include copies of the cover page or flowchart.
6. Site administrators will contact applicants in late October with funding results.
7. **Grantees must submit all requisitions to the District Office before December 20, 2023. Your funds will no longer be available after December 20, 2023.**

- STEM Classroom equipment • Woodshop equipment (3-D printer, power tools)
- Library books • Science class equipment (microscopes, electronic balances)
